District Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop thoughtful, accessible remote plans using stakeholder input, when possible. • Support schools in planning and implementing remote learning plans. • Help schools identify needed resources in the community (academic, health, social, emotional).
School Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Implement remote learning plans. • Communicate regularly with all stakeholders. • Support teachers in planning and implementing remote learning plans. • Help families find needed resources in the community (academic, health, social).
Teacher Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make remote learning activities available in a timely manner. • Be available at scheduled times to answer student/caregiver questions. • Communicate regularly with students. • Provide a range of meaningful learning opportunities that meet the needs of all learners during the period of closure. • Provide regular feedback to students on progress related to learning activities. • Log interactions with students/parents in Power School. • Follow district remote learning schedule.
Student Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Review assigned work. • Complete your assigned work. • Ask clarifying questions when you need help or don't understand. • Be respectful to yourself, teachers and peers.
Parent/ Caregiver/ Family Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Review work assigned to the student. • Reserve a space for students to complete remote learning work. • Encourage students to get enough sleep. • Set sensible time limits for technology use. • Talk with students about their work every day. • Help students establish and follow regular daily routines.
